20 Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God. 21 For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

W E A R E G O D ' S A M B A S S A D O R S

Ambassador- an accredited diplomat sent by a country as its official representative to a foreign country.

As an ambassador of Christ who belongs to the Kingdom of Heaven, we must be a representative for God while in this foreign, temporary world. We must represent Jesus by showing His love and telling people the Good News of what Jesus has done for them.

YOU ARE EQUIPPED

18 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

GOD MAKES US ADEQUATE TO MINISTER THE GOOD NEWS

TELL PEOPLE ABOUT THE GOSPEL

The word Gospel means "good story", a rendering of the Latin and the Greek, meaning "good news" or "good telling."

When we share the Good News it should be "good" not negative. We should be giving people a revelation of God's love for them and what Jesus has done for them.

JESUS LOVES YOU AND DIED FOR YOU

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

JESUS GIVES FORGIVENESS OF SINS

For this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.

- Matthew 26:28



JESUS GIVES ETERNAL LIFE

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

- John 3:16



JESUS MAKES YOU A PART OF GOD'S FAMILY

But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:

- John 1:12



Once you have shared the Good News of Jesus with someone their job is to believe and confess.

S A M P L E P R A Y E R O F S A L V A T I O N

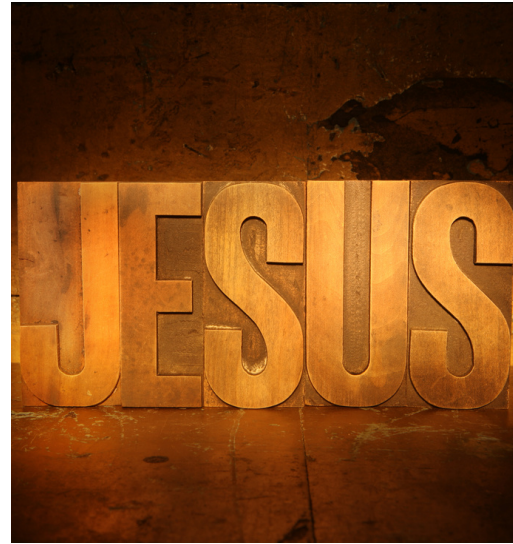
Lord Jesus, I confess that I am a sinner and I need You. I choose to repent and turn away from my sins. Today I choose to turn to You and only follow You.
